Amendment Details:

This Standard supersedes CC-STY-04005 dated June 2016. The principle changes from the previous standard are:

- a) The term Temporary Safety Measures Inspector has replaced Inspection Team Member.
- b) The qualification requirements for a Temporary Safety Measures Inspector now include a Technician with five years post graduate experience with minimum of one years' experience in the design or construction of road projects.

Amendment Details:

The following minor amendment has been incorporated into the December 2017 version of this Standard:

- a) Section 2 updated to clarify that both the Engineer and Technician shall have relevant experience in traffic management related works.

1. Introduction

1.1 General

The objective of this document is to set out the current qualification requirements for an individual, appointed to carry out Inspections on the national road network in accordance with CC-STY-04002 Temporary Safety Measures Inspections.

2. Qualifications

Temporary Safety Measures Inspector

The Temporary Safety Measures Inspector shall fulfil one of the following criteria;

- The Inspector shall be an Engineer or Technician with five years post graduate experience and shall have a minimum of one years' experience in the design or construction of road projects. The Engineer/ Technician shall also have relevant experience in traffic management related works; or
- The Inspector shall be a safety professional with seven years post graduate experience and shall have a minimum of five years' experience in the design or construction of road projects. The safety professional shall also have relevant experience in traffic management related works; or
- The Inspector shall be a Temporary Traffic Operations Supervisor (TTOS) and shall hold a valid SLG CSCS card with ten years of relevant experience in traffic management related works.


An Inspector shall have attended at a minimum, a one-day certified course in the design or auditing of Temporary Traffic Management.
