


#### **GE-GEN-01005** Departures from Standards

#### What is a Departure from Standard?

A Departure from Standard is defined as a deviation from the requirements of TII Standards and may mean any of the following:

- a) The use of technical design standards and/or specifications other than those in TII Standards;
- b) The use of a set of requirements or additional criteria for any aspect of the works for which requirements are not defined in the Specification or Requirements for Measurement and Pricing;
- The use of a technical design standard or specification in a manner or circumstance which is not permitted or provided for in such directive or specification;
- d) The use of a combination of Relaxations as set out in the relevant Standards;
- e) A combination of any of the above.






#### **Departure Decisions**

Departures applications are submitted via the online Departures Portal, reviewed by TII and is returned to the Applicant as one of the following:


- Accepted: A Departure providing an acceptable solution in the particular circumstances for that element of the works provided that any mitigation measures proposed by the Designer or conditional to that acceptance are also incorporated into the design and works.
- **Refused:** A Departure that is unacceptable to TII. The Applicant may submit a new Departure Application with an alternative solution.
- Rejected: A Departure with insufficient, inappropriate, or contradictory information where it is not possible to form a conclusive decision. The Applicant has the option to provide additional information to address the reasons for rejection and resubmit if they so wish.






<sup>\*\*</sup> Any Departure from the mandatory requirements of TII Standards must be formally accepted by TII prior to incorporation into the design and works as outlined in this Standard. Acceptance cannot be given retrospectively. \*\*

#### **Common Issues**


- Departures must be 'Parked' before supporting documents can be uploaded.
- Departures submitted prematurely not confirmed if it will be incorporated into the design at time of submission.
- No supporting information submitted text only submission.
- Wrong standard selected, or mis-quoted reference within departure application form.
- Departure centre point is incorrect select it on the map!






# DN-GEO-03030 - Design Phase Procedure for Road Safety Improvement Schemes, Urban Renewal Schemes and Local Improvement Schemes

"This standard is to be used for the design phase of all schemes on national roads, whether funded by TII or not, which have design elements, which have a cost estimate of less than €5m and which are not otherwise being progressed in accordance with the procedures set out in the TII Project Management Guidelines, PE-PMG-02041."







## **Examples where DN-GEO-03030 is applicable (non-exhaustive list)**

#### Examples where this Standard is applicable.


- A commercial development being promoted by a private entity which accesses a National Road.
- A rural greenway being funded by government grants that crosses a National Road.
- A tidy towns scheme from local fundraising that enhances a village on a National Road.
- A roundabout sponsorship scheme that proposes to erect a structure in the central island of a roundabout on a National Road.
- A traffic calming scheme designed in accordance with DMURS on a national road in a rural town.
- An upgrade of a junction on a National Road to increase capacity.
- The provision of new vehicle restraint systems along a National Road.
- The widening of a structure on a National Road.
- The introduction of a nearside passing bay as part of a PARR scheme.

All examples are for schemes with a cost estimate below €5M for the portion of the works associated with the National Road interface.



#### The Design Report – What is it?

- The purpose of the Design Report is to address and present issues relating to compliance with the relevant parts of the TII Publications (Standards) for the preferred option.
  - Should address technical elements only.
- Design Reports must be submitted for review via the TII Departures Portal registration & access as per GE-GEN-01005.
- Should be submitted prior to Statutory Processes. E.g. part 8

#### The Design Report – What is Required?

- Contents as per sample report
  - If headings are not relevant these should be marked as N/A.
  - Headings can be added as deemed necessary.
- Design Drawings updated to incorporate RSA comments prior to submission of design report.
- Road Safety Audit to include signed feedback form.
- Total Scheme Budget (refer to PE-PMG-02044).
- Project Appraisal Balance Sheet.
- Departure Application Forms.
- DMURS Compliancy Statement where applicable.

#### The Design Report – Common Issues!

- Report format varies significantly from sample report and/or not enough information provided on the proposed scheme.
- Design Drawings
  - Not updated to incorporate RSA comments prior to submission of design report.
  - Insufficient detail provided to allow for complete review.
- Road Safety Audit
  - Does not to include signed feedback form.
  - Where required, exceptions report are to be approved by TII prior to acceptance of the design report.
  - Appropriate RSA not complete Stage 2 appropriate for most schemes!
- Departure Application Forms referenced within body of report but individual departure application forms not included as an appendix.
- DMURS Compliancy Statement not provided where applicable.




